

ORDINANCE NO.: 2009-04-02

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE USE OF MEMORIAL PARK SOCCER FIELD

WHEREAS, at the present time, the City of Leeds owns and maintains Memorial Park Soccer Field ("Field") and desires to put in place rules and regulations for the use and reservation of such Field.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Leeds as follows:

1. All of the "Whereas" clauses are incorporated by reference.
2. The Field shall be used only for playing soccer and not for any other purpose such as golf, football or frisbee games.
3. No pets of any type on the Field.
4. City of Leeds youth soccer league games have priority over any other practice, game or event.
5. No adult or non-league play during City of Leeds youth soccer games.
6. No playing or trespassing on the Field from June 1 through August 1 of any given year so as to allow time for field rejuvenation.
7. No alcohol of any type at the Field.
8. No littering at the Field.
9. No loud radios at the Field.
10. Non-sanctioned Leeds Youth Sports Tournament or League play without reservation and clearance from City of Leeds or the Leeds Park Board is prohibited.
11. The Field may be reserved for tournament or league play. League and tournament fees apply. Call 699-2585 to reserve Field and to inquire as to fees.
12. Violation of these rules will result in ejection from the Field and a fine of up to \$500 dollars for each violation.
13. Any complaints or violations are to be reported to the Leeds Police Department by calling 699-2581.


