

ORDINANCE NO.: 2010-07-04

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE USE OF TENNIS COURTS

WHEREAS, at the present time, the City of Leeds owns and maintains several tennis courts located at the Leeds Civic Center ("Tennis Courts"), and the City of Leeds desires to put in place rules and regulations for the use of the Tennis Courts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Leeds as follows:

1. All of the "Whereas" clauses are incorporated by reference.
2. The Tennis Courts shall be used only for playing tennis and not for any other purpose, such as skateboarding, rollerblading, roller skating, kickball, football, or handball.
3. Proper tennis attire is required for anyone using the Tennis Courts, including proper tennis shoes. Cleats, black-soled shoes, and shoes with any type of wheels are not permitted on the Tennis Courts.
4. No pets of any type on the Tennis Courts.
5. The Tennis Courts are used on a "first come, first served" basis.
6. No alcohol of any type at the Tennis Courts.
7. No littering at the Tennis Courts.
9. No loud radios at the Tennis Courts.
10. Violation of these rules will result in ejection from the Tennis Courts and a fine of up to \$500 dollars for each violation.
